Speaker: Mark Bohach- WLOH Radio

Mark gave a history of WLOH from it's origin in 1948 as WHOK. Station was founded by three local businessmen who saw the need for a local station. In 1958 WHOK-FM was started. In 1981, WHOK-AM was changed to WLOH which stands for **W**ere **L**ancaster **O**hio. In 1997, WLOH was sold to Mark and Arlene Bohach. In 1999, Ed Johnson from the Agri Broadcasting Network purchased WLOH from the Bohach Family. Ed Johnson passed away shortly after the sale was finalized. In 2005, The Bohachs re-purchased WLOH from the Johnson family.
