Gabrel is from Sau Paulo, Federative Republic of Brazil. If we took all the people from Ohio and put them into Columbus, this is the population of his home town. Brazil is the 5th largest country in the world and is ½ the land in South America, and has close to 5,000 miles of coast line, with 26 states and 1 federal district. Gabrel has 2 brothers, 5 cats and 2 dogs. There homes are close together with little yard area and all have a fence in the front. In 2006 Brazil became self sufficient in oil. They have flex cars which can take 3 different types of fuel, gas, and Alcool, which is Brazilian ethanol and were the 1st in the world to use it. They also have GNV cars, which are vehicles that run on natural gas. They have one of the best electronic banking systems and ultra deep water technology. Gabrel shared with us, the festivals of the area, the music, foods, sports, and tourism. Rio De Janeiro has the most famous beaches in the world and in 2006 had a 270 foot Christmas tree, the tallest in the world.
