Guest Speaker: Debbie Zwicker-Script Assist Coordinator@ FMC and Fairfield Medical center Foundation

Debbie started as the Script Assist Coordinator in 2009 when the hospital noticed that patients on Medicare/Medicaid were going home with orders for prescriptions that they couldn't afford to get filled, so consequently, they ended up back in the hospital.

The Script Assist program has over 1200 patients enrolled and has an easy application to fill out. Applications must be filled out yearly to continue on the program. Once you have filled out the application and are accepted, your medicine will either go to your Doctor's office for pick-up or mailed directly to your home. You receive a 90-day supply and a reorder must be called in before each supply runs out.
