Open Discussion:

- Discussion about PRGL becoming a member of Destination Downtown Lancaster. Can join at the "Supporter" level for \$100. Sara made the motion that we join at the Supporter level, David W. seconded the motion, all present approved. Cheryl will get the application filled out and submitted since DDL is located in her office. Invoice will be sent to Dee for payment.
- Discussion about PRGL purchasing a tree for \$200, to be placed in the Rising park Arboretum being constructed on Orchard Hill. Tree will have a plaque put in front stating that the tree was donated by Progressive Referral Group of Lancaster. Dee was to check and see if there were still any available. Tree is the preferred option but if not available, it was suggested PRGL could possibly join the Friends of the Parks. Discussion was tabled until we find out if a tree is available.

Addendum to meeting minutes: after the meeting, we were informed that there were a limited number of trees still available. Jeff Metzger, PRGL President, sent out an email vote to the membership, asking for approval to go ahead and purchase the tree. As of 3-12-2021, the group has voted in favor of the purchase. A tree has been put in reserve for the group, and will be confirmed, once the voting ends on Monday, March 15th.

- Group discussed meeting space options for in-person meetings, once we are able gather again. Buckeye Toyota can fit up to 20 people in their meeting space and has wi-fi to continue zoom meetings, as well as options for coffee and drinks.
- PRGL board is also looking at a few other suggestions before making a final decision on a meeting space.

Since there are still certain restrictions and social distancing isn't available, it was the groups consensus to wait and explore that as an option when health guidelines are lifted. Also need to see how they are set up for zoom meetings, as zoom is something we may want to continue offering.
