Jenn reviewed the different things to look for when putting together your Power of Attorney. She recommends putting all of your wishes in writing so your POA knows the authority they have. If you have an old Power of Attorney, she recommends it be reviewed, as things have changed

And some of your wishes may no longer be viable.

Other forms she recommended having done are a Healthcare POA as well as a Living Will.
