- The annual PRGL Christmas Party will be December 9th, so there will be no meeting that morning. Scholarships for non-profits will be awarded to the recipients at the December 16th meeting. Non-profit nominations will be due by December 2nd. More than 1 member may submit a nomination for the same non-profit, but can only win 1 scholarship. Non-profits who won in 2020 are not eligible to be submitted this year. Winners from 2020 were: Ohio Glass Museum, The Key to Giving, Grace Haven, C & C Wellness and Life Line of Ohio. Drawing for this year's scholarships will be held at the December 9th Christmas party.
