Telehealth was widely used during the Covid-19 shut down.

Today, there are more services offered:

Telehealth bundle:

- Telemedicine-unlimited access to doctors, 24/7, for all members of your household
- Mental (Behavioral) Health- access to counselors 24/7
- Medical Savings – dental, vision, eyecare

Plans start at 19.95/mo. for telehealth, \$39.95/mo. For Mental Health, or \$49.95/mo. for both plans.
