Bill discussed the process of adding, editing, and updating your PRGL profile on the website www.prgl.org. He can set up the member info if you prefer and you will then receive an email from WordPress with your user name and password. Once you have the info, log in and be sure to save your password. Once in to the website, mouse over your name. Click edit my profile. You can then add your headshot and banner/ logo. Once complete, you can then add a synopsis about what your business is and services offered. If you have problems, call Bill to help guide you through the process.
