**Speaker: Adam VanDyke-Business Director of Orthopedics at Fairfield Medical Center**

Adam reviewed information from the State of the Center flyer (see attached) including the new TAVR procedure that is now offered at FMC, which is not as invasive as open-heart surgery.

He also discussed the Robotic-Assisted surgery as well as the Electrophysiology service now being offered at Fairfield Medical Center. Adam also discussed the addition of the Linear Accelerator to treat cancer patients with less treatments and shorter treatment times. Special thanks to the Fairfield Medical Center Foundation for their donation to bring this to the patients at Fairfield Medical Center.

The River Valley Campus was built to help alleviate the response time for care, especially for those on the west side of town. For those that need to be admitted, RV Campus Emergency Department will arrange transportation to the main campus via ambulance service.

Goals for FMC in 2023 include:
