Fairfield County Health Department is made up of several divisions.

Administrative Division is responsible for community health improvement plan and working with other agencies.

Environmental Division handles inspections for water, sewage, food service and restaurant, tattoo and piercing businesses, school safety, campgrounds and solid waste facilities. They also investigate dog and wild animal bites and handle mosquito spraying for the county.

Nursing Division handles covid and flu vaccinations and children with health issues.

Vital Statistics- is responsible for all birth and death certificates and records storage.

Health Promotion- the focus is prevention, tobacco cessation, suicide prevention, transportation to health care. Includes promoting the 988 Suicide Prevention Hotline.

WIC Division- pregnant woman, infants and children up to five years. Nutrition assistance and education.
