Speaker: Jo Welsh- Bottoms Up Diaper Bank

Bottoms Up Diaper Bank is based at Connexion West and distributes 80,000 diapers per month in 16 counties.

The 'World's Largest Diaper Drive' was started a few years ago and initially collected 360,000 diapers. Last year, it grew to 500,000 diapers. This year's goal is 750,000 diapers.

Requests for diapers are handled through 211 Information and Referral in Fairfield County. The biggest demand is for diapers in sizes 4, 5, 6.
