Speaker: Erin Harvey- Keller Market House

Erin manages both the Keller Market House and the Lancaster Farmers Market.

Keller Market House- has been in operation for seven years and is a 501c3 non-profit organization. It operates on a consignment model and is always taking applications for new vendors. They just received a USDA grant to remodel the back half of the building. They accept SNAP benefits. Some of the items featured in the store include baked goods, fried pies, micro greens and fresh mushrooms. The organization is sustained by grants, sponsorships and memberships.

Lancaster Farmers Market- founded in 1983. It runs 23 weeks each year and is on Saturday mornings. The location is in the parking lot behind the Courts Building. They are now taking vendor applications for the 2023 season. Pricing is \$230 for the entire season or \$25 per individual Saturday.
