Speaker: Dave young- Minuteman Press

Dave showed examples of yard signs, banners and other printed promotional materials. Yard signs are printed on a 4X8 ft sheet and custom cut into 10 or 20 signs. Cost for the sheet is \$150. Signs are usually a three day turnaround.

For banners, Dave mentioned high resolution printing, welded edges and grommets are all standard. Minuteman Press also can provide vehicle wrap materials, reflective signs, wall tack stickers and printed fabrics and mesh for vehicles.

Minuteman Press can provide complete design services. Molly worked for Promotions By Design and does lots of custom work for customers. Examples include custom books, fliers, invitations and greeting cards. Design services are usually \$30 per hour.

Mail Services are also provided and can be customized by demographic, profession, income and interests.
