Culligan offers new drinking stations to replace water fountains and eliminating bottles. This is a better solutions it eliminates unpredictable expenses and the troubles with bottled water delivery. You can get models that have an ice maker built in.

Tap water has many contaminants not generally known by the public. It is not uncommon to find 200-300 parts per million of dissolved solids in typical tap water. Another issue is benzene which can cause leukemia.

There are two methods of water purification. These are steam distillation and reverse osmosis. Culligan has developed state of the art reverse osmosis systems for their equipment.
