FairHoPe Hospice has been in Fairfield County for 40 years. FairHoPe stands for FAIR field HO cking and PE rry counties. They can provide service to anyone within one hour of the Pickering House. The Pickering House is a twelve bed facility located on 38 acres. It is available for those who need pain management and for families who need respite care. A new office in Logan recently opened.

Some services provided by FairHoPe include nurses, chaplain, STNAs and volunteers to assist. Hospice is designed for those with six months or less to live and is about quality of life.
